Visit Major Attractions like Ho Chi Minh Complex, Temple of Literature & Ngoc Son Temple Ha long Bay Cruise:

Halong Bay is one of the most beautiful and impressive sight, emerald waters and thousands of towering limestone islands topped by rainforests.

Da Nang City:

Visit Ba Na Hills through Cable car, Golden Bridge & Le Jardin, remains of French Villas and Ling Ung Pagoda, waterfalls & Fantasy Park etc.

Ho Chi Minh City:

Visit Independence Palace symbolizes Vietnam's victory, peace, and territorial integrity later Visit War Remnants Museum: Formerly known as the Museum of American War Crimes

AnkorWat – The World famous & biggest temple complex in the middle of water, Ta Prohm, Bapoun, Bayon Temples, Night Market.

Visit the "Killing Fields" of Choeng Ek, Independence monument for photo shooting and Psa Thmey market & Visit Russian Market (Toul Tumpong Market) the Market is very popular among the tourist. Visit National Museum & Wat Phnom Temple is one of the most important pagodas in Phnom Penh

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Bangalore to Vietnam (Hanoi)

Assemble at Bangalore International airport, complete the immigration formalities @ KIAL. Take the flight to Vietnam. On arrival at Noi Bai International Airport @ Hanoi, after immigration formalities collect the luggage, you will be transferred to Hanoi hotel,

Day 2 Hanoi Full day Hanoi sightseeing (B/L/D)

After Breakfast at hotel, visit Ho Chi Minh Complex. A traffic-free area of botanical gardens, monuments, memorials and pagodas, the famous One Pillar Pagoda which is built of wood on a single stone pillar 1.25 m in diamete. Have lunch at Indian restaurant.

Later visit the Temple of Literature (Vietnamese name is Quoc Tu Giam) – Vietnam's first University, which was built in 1070 in honor of Confucius, Continue to visit Tran Quoc Pagoda, the oldest Buddhist temple in Hanoi. visit Ngoc Son Temple which is located at the northern end of Sword Lake (Hoan Kiem Lake) & Ly Thai Statue. Stay overnight in Hanoi.



Day 3 Hanoi - Ha Long Bay and stay overnight on Cruise (B/L/D)

After Breakfast at hotel we leave Hanoi Descending to the Sea. Halong bay, "Dragon Bay is one of the most beautiful and impressive sights in Vietnam. Ha Long Bay has twice been recognized by UNESCO as a World Natural Heritage Area for its exceptional scenic beauty and one of the world's greatest natural wonders. Upon arrival, we will embark to an overnight Cruise. Check in your beautiful room with ocean view from your bed. Lunch at cruise's luxury restaurant while the cruise goes around limestone islands, floating villages and beaches on Ha Long bay...Stop for visiting the cave, Swimming, Kayaking if weather permitted. Have dinner on board. Overnight onboard.



Day 4 Ha Long Bay - Hanoi - Da Nang (B/Brunch/D)

Early morning, experience enjoy sunrise behind mountains on the bay. Having light breakfast and continue the cruise to see other part of Halong Bay. Having Brunch on the cruise and disembark at around 11:30 am and return to Hanoi, transfer to the airport to take a flight to Da Nang. Overnight in Da Nang.



Day 5 Da Nang - Ba Na Hills - Golden Bridge (B/Buffet Lunch/ D)

After Breakfast at hotel depart to Ba Na Hills, one of the most spectacular landscapes of Danang City.

You will take a cable car to the summit of mountain (at 1487m of sea level). Start visiting Ba Na Hill with many different attractions: Funicular, Debay ancient wine cellar & Le Jardin D'Amour, Linh Ung pagoda, Thich Ca Buddhist statue, etc.. Have buffet lunch on Bana Hills (Indian corner). Continue to join activities and games in Fantasy Park. Later walk to the summit of the mountain at the height 1487m — the highest one of Ba Na Mountain, visit Bell Tower, Nghinh Phong tower and Golden Bridge, to take beautiful photos of the mountain and Da Nang city. Late afternoon, taking the cable car back to foothill. Transfer back to your hotel. Time at leisure. Have dinner in the Indian restaurant. Overnight at hotel in Danang



Day 6 Da Nang - Ho Chi Minh city - Cu Chi Tunnels Tour (B, L, D)

After the Breakfast/Packed Breakfast proceed to Da Nang air port for connecting flight to Ho Chi Minh.

Arrive Tan Son Nhat airport (Ho Chi Minh) you are welcome and transfer to Ho Chi Minh City center. Have lunch in the Indian restaurant. Continue depart to Cu Chi will take approximately one and a half hours bus driving. Upon arrival, before exploring the tunnels, you will have some short introduction followed by introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed and how the people survived in the harsh conditions of the war time. Then, spend your time to explore the remaining area and tunnel systems which included the special constructed living areas with kitchens, bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers helping whoever lives inside the tunnels meet their basic needs.



Besides, there are also many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security purpose during the war. Afterward, special tea and cassava (guerilla's food during the war) will be served. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 7 Ho Chi Minh City Tour – Siem Reap (B,L,D)

Have breakfast and check out hotel. Start Ho Chi Minh City tour with a visit to the Reunification Hall

which includes: formal meeting rooms, private bedrooms, war situation rooms 10 meter beneath earth's level. The guide will show you important historical facts about this building and some French colonial structures, the Notre Dame Cathedral, General Post Office, The City Hall and the last one is Opera House. Followed by the remarkable site of the War Remnants Museum the museum has a vast display of the both the Indochina wars. Have lunch time in the Indian restaurant. In the afternoon, visit to Cho Lon (Big Market) and Thien Hau Pagoda which is located in China Town. Shopping at Ben Thanh



market, Saigon Square. Depend on your flight, transfer to Tan Son Nhat airport for Siem Reap upon Arrival transfer to Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 8 Siem Reap - Angkor Thom & Angkor Wat (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, Head to Ta Prohm, one of the area's most beautiful temples which has been left relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery. Its appeal lies in the fact that, unlike the other monuments of Angkor, it was abandoned and swallowed by the jungle, looking very much the ways most of the Angkor temples appeared when European explorers first stumbled upon them, it was used as a location in the film Tomb Raider. Then head to see the last and

most enduring capital city of the Khmer empire, Angkor Thom, the Great Angkor City, established in the late twelfth century by King Jayavarman VII. We also visit the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King & Baphoun temple before continue to visit Angkor Wat, the most popular tourist attraction in Cambodia-it is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Angkor Wat, also known as the "City of Temples" a temple complex in Cambodia and one of the largest religious monuments in the world, on a site measuring 162.6 hectares.



Originally constructed as a Hindu temple dedicated to the god Vishnu for the Khmer Empire, it was gradually transformed into a Buddhist temple towards the end of the 12th century. Seeing the architectural masterpiece of Angkor Wat. We stroll around this massive monument, exploring the many galleries with columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple. Return to hotel and free until time go to have dinner. Then enjoy dinner at Indian restaurant and. Overnight stay at Hotel in Siem Reap.

Day 9 Siem Reap – Phnom Penh (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel check out & proceed to Phnom Penh, transfer by private vehicle with guide to

Phnom Penh (314km/6hrs drives). Have lunch before check at hotel and relax. (05:00pm – 06:30pm) – Enjoy private sunset cruise along Chaktomuk River!

This tour is one hour and thirty minutes and will give you a great opportunity to explore the Mekong, Tonle Sap and Four Faces River, Diamond Island, Fishing Village, Stilted Houses, lifestyle of the people who live along the riverbank and the city sunset. Enjoy 1-2 cold drinks before disembarking and transfer to have dinner before drop off at your hotel. Overnight in Phnom Penh



Day 10 Phno Penh's City Tour (B/L/D)

After Breakfast at hotel, visit to Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum (from S21 prison). This prison was a secondary school, and used as a prison by Pol Pot's security forces and became the largest detention and torture center under the Khmer Rouge regime. Follow by visit the Killing Fields at Cheung Ek. At noon, visit to one of Phnom Penh's most iconic landmarks, The Royal Palace, is a complex of buildings

which serves as the royal residence of the King of Cambodia. Next is The National Museum, one of the world's greatest collections of Khmer cultural material including sculpture, ceramics, pottery, bronzes and ethnographic objects from the prehistoric, pre-Angkorian, Angkorian and post-Angkorian periods as well as more recent works, such as a beautiful wooden royal barge. Next is Wat Phnom "Mountain Pagoda"is a Buddhist temple that symbolizes the name of Phnom Penh, located on the hill. Wat Phnom is the most popular place for



local people come to play healthy spot or praying for their good luck as well as admire the sundown. If time permitted, visit PhsarThmey (Central Market), a large market constructed in 1937 in the shape of a dome with four arms branching out into vast hallways with countless stalls of goods. The four wings of this gigantic yellow dome are teeming with stalls that sell goods ranging from gold and silver, antique coins, money exchange, books, flowers, food, fabrics, shoes, souvenirs, seafood and countless other products. Overnight in Phnom Penh

Day 11 Phnom Penh - Bangalore (B/L)

After Breakfast at hotel checkout Enjoy remaining of the day is your own leisure or shopping.. After lunch @ Indian Restaurant. Transfer to airport connecting flight to Bangalore
